

Berkley Motorist Pleads Not Guilty To Drunk Driving

A jury trial will be held June 15 for Robert Walker, 25, of Berkley, who was arrested on a drunk driving charge last Saturday after his car collided with two parked vehicles, on East Maple.

Police said Walker's auto struck a parked truck owned by Rose-Tool and Gage Co. of Hazel Park, shearing off a parking meter in front of 244 E. Maple, and then hit a parked car owned by Joseph R. Farnum of 497 Golfview.

Walker, police said, was treated for cuts and bruises. He was released by Justice John J. Gaffill on \$100 bond, after Walker pleaded not guilty to the charge yesterday.
