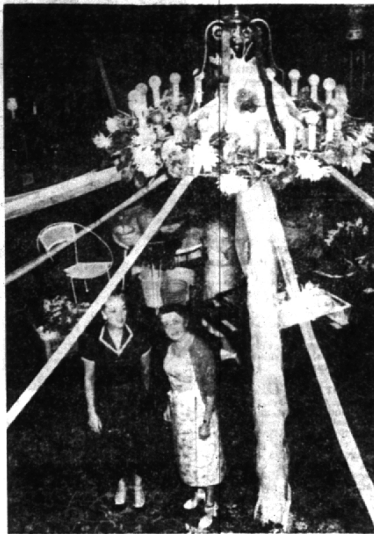


# Hills Women Wield Magic of May
