

### Players End '55 Season With a Hit

It's really too bad the Birmingham Village Players are not preparing for a summer program of road shows because in "Sabrina Fair" they have a hit on the boards.

A frequent comment as first nighters fled out of the Playhouse last Friday was, "It's the best they've ever done!" One man declared that in his ten years of steady attendance, he had not seen anything that could come near it. Audiences are first impressed by the entrance of Pat Dix, as she sits in complete shadow with a spotlight centered on her expressive face, and tells in a few brief words the background of "Sabrina Fair". When the curtain opens again, spontaneous applause tells the designers they have done an excellent job.

THE ENTIRE play takes place in the one setting, the walled garden of a Long Island estate. As the story unfolds the audience learns the oddities of character which makes each member of the wealthy Larabee family a distinct personality.

Father Larabee (Jack Hasberger) who makes a hobby of attending funerals, his patient and somewhat vague wife Maude (Hortense Adams) and his two sons, Linus, Jr. (Steve Mahand) dominant and forceful and David (Bud Christian) are perfect foils for each other's characteristics.

ON STAGE applause was given Harriet Fox for her role of Julia Ward McKinlock, family friend and houseguest, and to Walter Skinner, family chauffeur, book worm, and unexpectedly wealthy father of "Sabrina", played by Mrs. Dix.

An excellent supporting cast included Peggy McCall, Ruth Richardson, Barbara Oglesby, Doug Brown, Penny Kleene, Earl Wilson and Charles Blunt. Butch the cackler kept the audience in suspense as they waited for him (as Maurice, a French gift to Mrs. Larabee) to start singing French nursery rhymes. Butch remained Butch, a loyal American and didn't say a word. He did, however, give an excellent demonstration of cackler gymnastics as he performed in his cage.
