



Fees of Cranbrook Gardens Provide Four Scholarships

CRANBROOK — Daffodils and tulips have paved the way for four scholarship students to attend Kingswood and Cranbrook schools. The scholarships are financed by a small admission fee charged visitors to the gardens of Cranbrook House for the benefit of the two school scholarship fund. From these fees enough money was collected to provide financial aid for four day students, two going to each school, for two boarding students, one at Kingswood and the other at Cranbrook school. Alumni of the two schools have sponsored this gardens program over the past seven years. The gardens were closed Nov. 1 for the winter.
