

Lack of Track Site Forces Withdrawal Of Turf Club Bid

TROY—Application for a license to operate a race track at 14 Mile and John R has been withdrawn by

Michigan Thoroughbred Turf club by club attorneys who said the withdrawal in effect signified the end of the club as an organization.

Henry C. Murray and Joseph J. Marshall, the attorneys, in a letter to Racing Commissioner James H. Inglis, said withdrawal came after the club could not comply with requirements, "namely, the submit-

THE DECISION came after tonight's hearing reversed a previous approval of the track and fired Malcolm M. Heber, township attorney, after it was learned that he, along with Fred W. Hildebrandt, township treasurer, and Heber's law partner, Harry N. Dell, were principals in Esroh Corp., which had optioned the site.

Wilbur DeYoung, assistant attorney general, claimed at Detroit hearings on the application, that the Esroh backers, working with Turf club officials, would realize a \$125,000 profit on a \$1,000 investment, when they turned over options to the club.

Hildebrandt refused to resign because he had been elected to office, but appointed as had Heber.

Police Recruit Team to Explain Increase in Pay

A drive now is being conducted to obtain 200 more troopers authorized at the special session of the legislature to fight the highway accident toll.

Applications close November 30. Although men interested may call at a State Police post at any time or talk to any State Police officer, the recruiting team visit has been arranged for their convenience. The team will be at the U.S. Postoffice Building at Martin and Bates streets, from 2 to 8 p.m. Its members will be (Pl. Emmett Bradley and Sgt. Joseph Kenzierski of the Pontiac post.

Applicants must be between the ages of 21 and 25, inclusive, not less than five feet, nine inches in height, and have a high school education or its equivalent. Married men as well as single are accepted.
