Parent's Love Seen in Gift Expert Hopes

Children's toys and gifts should reflect their parents' love, not just their pocket books, according to Dr. Elmer Knowles of the home management and child development department at MSU. A common advice for many parents is "We have given our children everything we can afford, but we still don't know what to give them."

"UNLESS parents have given freely of themselves, Dr. Knowles says, the child is lacking what he needs most of all—unconditional love." Dorothy W. Baruch, authority in parent education, believes children need and want four emotional foods: "1. Unconditional love, acceptance of the child as he is; 2. A sense of belonging in the family group; 3. A feeling of being able

to stand on his own feet as an achieving person; and 4. a need for recognition.

TOYS AND PLAY are a serious business for a child. Dr. Knowles thinks parents should allow their children to explore as far as they can safely do so, but they should learn that some things are forbidden. Store-bought toys should be phobed and supplemented by contact with ordinary objects and experiences.

A good rule to guide you when buying a Christmas toy is this: Can Johnny invent lots of things to do with it? Is it suitable for his age? Is the toy sturdy enough so he can be as rough as he chooses with it?
