Livonia Man Jailed On Indecency Count

Paul R. Ivan, 27, of Livonia, survived examination of a gross indecency charge Friday before Justice John J. Gaffill who bound Ivan over to Oakland County circuit court for arraignment later this month.

According to Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley, Ivan, arrested last Thursday by Lt. Henry Timm and Det. Robert Schaule, admitted to Oakland county prosecutors that he was involved with eight boys, ranging in age from 9 to 12, during the past year.


Maximum sentence for gross indecency, a felony, is five years, Moxley said.
