Educator Tells Parents to Live Child's Examples

"Live well your own life, so that the values that are evident in your living are brought out in your child," an educator told 53 parents of Barnum school children last Thursday night.

The talk was discussion of "what makes 12 and 13-year-old boys and girls tick," first of three lectures on understanding of teenagers being sponsored by Barnum Parent-Teacher association at the school.

SPEAKER was Dr. John C. Sullivan, professor of educational psychology, Wayne university. His talk on what 12 and 13-year-olds are, preceded later talks on parental aids to that age youth, and third, by coordinator for the whole group, Dr. Harold F. Powell, a summary.

Powell is associate professor in same department with Sullivan at Wayne, as is second speaker, Dr. George D. Barahal.

"What is said to the child is not so important as maintaining proper values to serve as a guide to the child, he said.

"Use all the influence you have as a parent to pay attention to your child at this time," he stressed.
