Annual fall Gray-Yolds week was held Oct. 17-18 at Camp Olympia. Fifty boys and three girls attended.

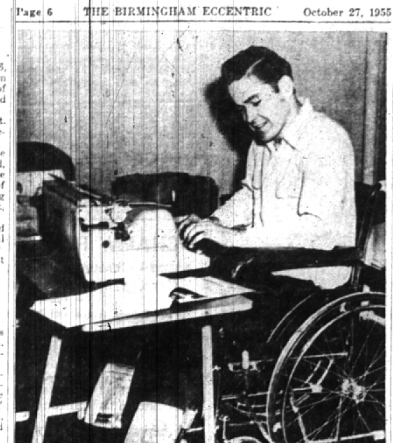

Oakland Sales Outlet For Handicapped Here

For a closure view of a Torch Fund agency in action, one may turn the corner from Woodward to Hamilton in Birmingham's business section, and walk a half block east to the League Shop.

Operated by the Detroit League for the Handicapped, a Torch Fund agency, and financed by local Junior League volunteers, the shop is the only Oakland county outlet for articles made by the League's home workers.

"The League is operated in the belief that the entire community benefits when the handicapped are able to make full use of their abilities," Mrs. Ward said.

She has worked as a visiting nurse for the Detroit League for the Handicapped, which is an important part of the League's activities. Handicapped persons work on salvage, hand assembly, packaging and similar tasks made possible by contracts with local business and industry.

"Expensive goods in the sheltered workshop often find placement in a competitive job market," Mrs. Ward said.

Actually, the great percentage of our handicapped persons are engaged in industrial work.
