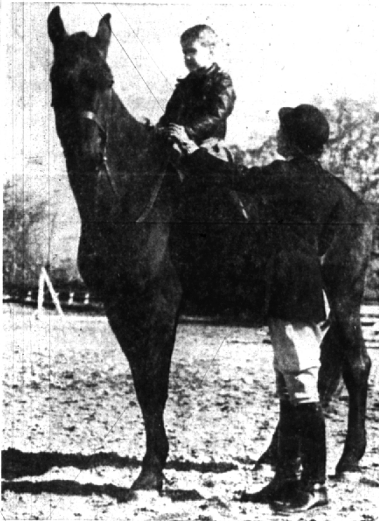
The event is main money-making method for the association, and Mrs. John Tate, wares and income chairman, is heading planning groups. Her co-chairman is Mrs. Walter Finn.
