During and since World War II grants were restricted to women from Latin-American countries. Frieda Calhoun, president of Birmingham Altrusa, Mariel Braine and Mrs. Myrl Oehm reported that at the recent biennial convention in Toronto the program was broadened to include Asiatic women.

For the coming year, \$20,000 has been allocated for grants to Latin-American women and \$5,000 for grants to Asiatic women graduate students. Current Birmingham Altrusa project is a survey of community resources for the aging, with the publication of a free handbook planned. Mrs. C. B. Lewis is chairman of the public affairs committee in charge of this project.

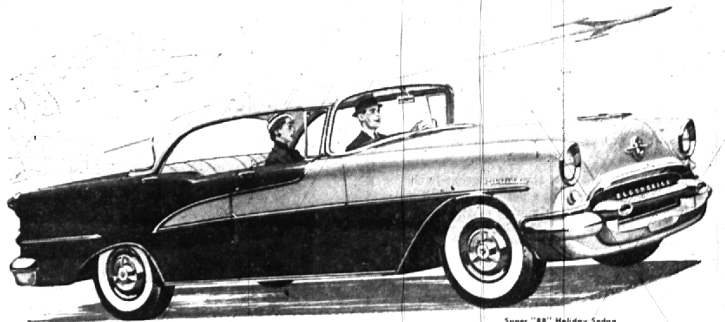
