Dr. Robert T. Hatt last Wednesday welcomed members of the Birmingham branch of the American Association of University Women to the Cranbrook Institute of Science which he directs.

Besides seeing the Institute, women heard reports from national convention delegates during the branch's first general meeting of the fall.

Alice Beeman, president of the Michigan division of AAUW, spoke on "Your AAUW as I saw it at the convention." mentioning a number of "specialists" in particular fields, coming from all over the country.

SHE SAID, "Each one of us can become an expert in one field, if we give only a little time each day to that subject. It is for the group as a whole to hear these women and then decide on a broad general policy governed by their recommendations."

Mr. Charles Shain, international relations chairman, spoke briefly on A. A. U. W. participation through an observer at United Nations meetings, and America's role as chief supporter of the International Federation of University Women.

MRS. BIRREIGH Laurimore, another delegate from Birmingham, summarized the "keynote" speech on "We Choose the Future." "Our education," she quoted, "did not fit us to choose. We must ourselves continue it, learn to adapt to change, get out of our routine, and live with dignity serenely."
