Walled Lake bunched its runners in second, third, fourth and

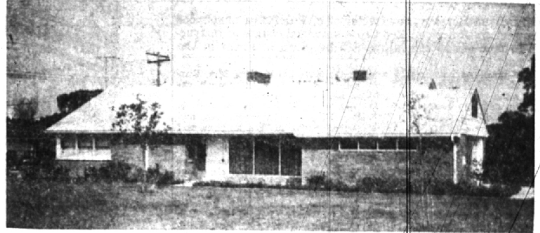

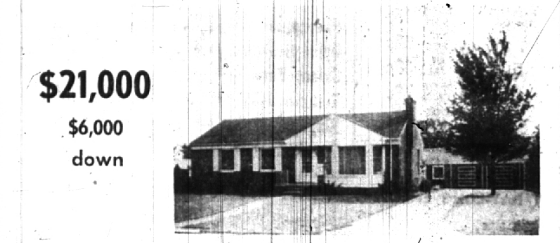

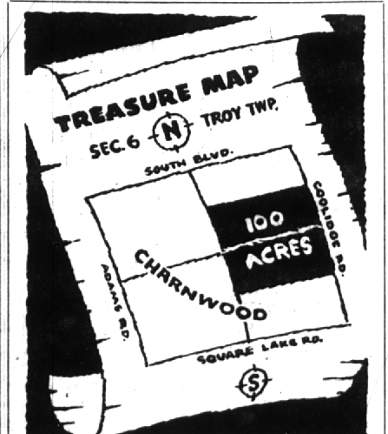
To Visit Ford Plant

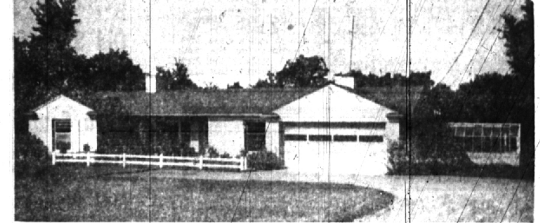

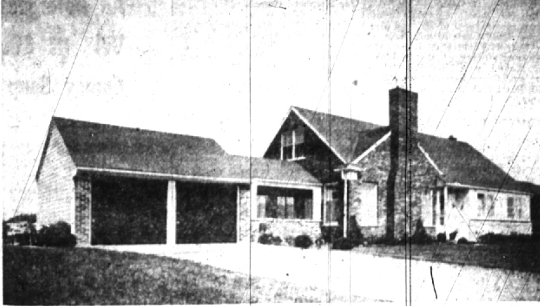
