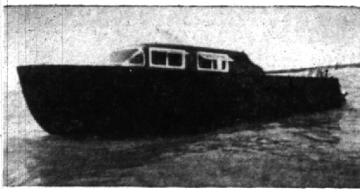

Built at Home, Boat Takes Bullocks Afloat

William Bullock, of Tibury, Bloomfield Village, built a boat. A lot of thought and planning went into this project. In fact, Bullock studied and planned for over two years before he came up with something that would meet all the requirements that he needed in a boat.

The type of boat he needed must be seaworthy, have speed and be portable so they could take it up long and has a seven and one-half foot beam. It is powered by twin 30-horse power Scott-Atwater motors.

BULLOCK started building his boat and has a cruising speed of "dream-child" last November and approximately 22 miles per hour finished it in July so he and the with a top speed of 33 miles per family have enjoyed it for the first hour summer this year.

weighs 1400 pounds and has a galley and sleeping quarters for two. It can be operated either from inside or from the aft cockpit. Like a modern car, it has a wrap-around windshield. The boat was built up from a seven-ply moulded plywood shell.

IN JULY the family first launched the new boat at Harbor Springs, where they cruised for a week, while staying at Cross Village. Aug. 1 they took it to Traverse City for two weeks of cruising this area and to North Port Pt. and Sutton Bay, and Charlevoix.

Bullock later took two fishing trips with buddies. First, they were at Petoskey and fished in the Beaver Island area. The second trip they put in at Mackinaw City and fished in the Straits vicinity.

The boat is now in Lake St. Clair river at Mt. Clemens for the remainder of the fishing season.

A SPECIAL trailer carries Bullock's boat. Its airplane wheels with hydraulic mechanism can be lifted and lowered to raise mounting the boat. In this way, Bullock is able to put the boat in and out of the water easily.

Bullock's hobby is "aqua-jungling." He enjoys exploratory diving for wrecked ships. This coming Saturday he plans to dive in Lake Huron with three other men. They have a wrecked ship spotted there which sank about 15 years ago with about 50 people sealed in their cabins. It lies in about 40 to 50 feet of water and its cargo is unknown.

SEVERAL TIMES Bullock has been diving in Lake St. Clair. Next summer he has an interesting date with a diving buddy from Traverse City. This man, two years ago was on a ship that went down just off N. Manitou Island. It was a 70-foot sailing vessel. They will attempt to salvage some of the ship's "rigging."

This is a busy family. Mrs. Bullock is an ardent golf enthusiast. They have four children. The two older daughters, Marcia, 12, and Anne, 10, are great swimmers. Taking advantage of the Oakland Hills pool, they have already achieved speeds comparable to the leading swimmers in the state in their age groups.

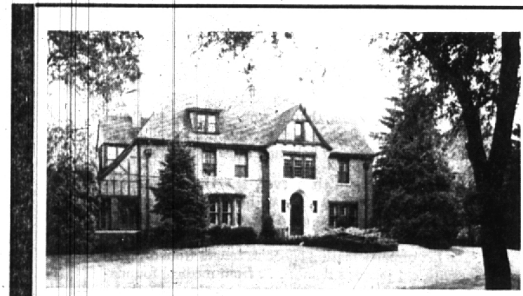
