You scarcely look at the endorsement on a check, even though you accept it from a stranger, and that can lead to trouble.

I'm one who thinks that you can trust almost everyone, and so far I haven't been caught with a check that bounced. I know several business men who have been stuck once or twice, though, and you can't blame them for being mighty cautious now about checks, particularly about knowing who endorsed it. Take Jack Storm down at the neighborhood hardware store, for example. He's one who will warn you—emphatically, with gestures—that it's smart to follow the simple rule: "Know your endorser."

OUR LAWS set up many rules to protect us, and one of these rules protects the holder of a check by declaring that if he can't collect from the person who wrote out the check (the drawer), he can collect from the person who signed the check over to him (endorsed it). This, of course, applies only where a check changes hands at least once.

I mentioned Jack Storm. He accepted a \$100 check from a nice looking fellow who said he needed to buy a kit of tools for his new job. I won't use real names, but let's say the check was made out to Will Works and signed by Art Jayson.

"Sure, Art Jayson's lived in the neighborhood for twenty years," Jack said. "I know him well. Just sign your name on the back."

*JACK FORGOT to identify the endorser, and it turned out that Will Works was a phony name, and that Art Jayson's signature was a forgery. Jack had no idea where to find the stranger, and he ended up losing about \$40 in tools and \$80 cash.

Right after that a good friend,

I'll call him Bob Samson, bought a \$2 paintbrush from Jack, and gave him a \$50 check. It was made out to a Paul Smart and signed with "Eggo's Canning Co., Inc., Rex Rogue, President." Bob Samson placed his signature beneath it and Jack gave friend Bob the paintbrush and \$58 change.

Well, there wasn't any "Eggo's Canning Co., Inc.," and this check also was worthless. But it was a different story this time for Jack. He got a hold of Bob Samson, and, of course, Bob had to make good on his endorsement.

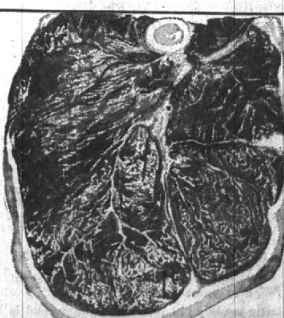
