- Establishing a new lawn. Details next week. In the meantime...
  - Don't buy top soil and spread a couple of inches on top of the clay expecting to have a lawn.
  - Take a pint of soil to your Oakland County Agricultural Agent in Pontiac for test and analysis. It will save you money in the long run.
  - Determine the type of lawn you need or want or can afford and select the seed accordingly. Don't forget you can spend \$1.50 in preparing the lawn bed and then throw it away trying to save \$10 or \$15 on the seed specifications.
  - Be specific about the technique of spreading the fertilizer and seed, the raking, rolling and watering.

- Improving the established lawn.
  - Fertilizer (probably 10-6-1) for development of strong plants in the wonderful Fall growing period.
  - Need for filling in thin and bare spots.
  - Kill or eliminate weeds by one method or another before seeding.
  - Be careful about wasting seed by sloppy application.

## WEED KILLING

There are so many weeds and so many killers that it is no wonder you and me might become confused. However, at this point we will mention a few important tips to be kept in mind.

- Annual weeds will not show up next year. However, they will produce seeds which will germinate next year.
- Kill the plant and seeds now by:—
  - Spraying with proper material
  - Cutting off foliage at root.
  - Raking and close mowing.

- These weeds must be killed and their seeds annihilated.
