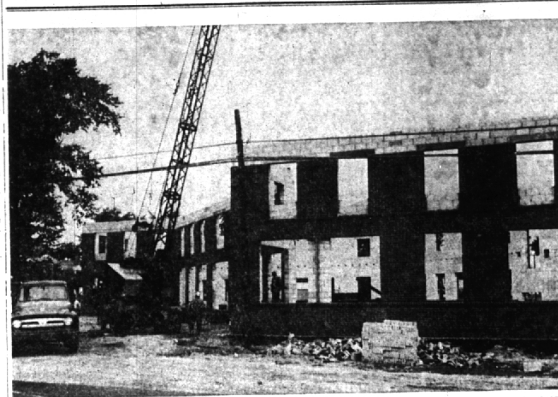
McGill Receives Insurance Award

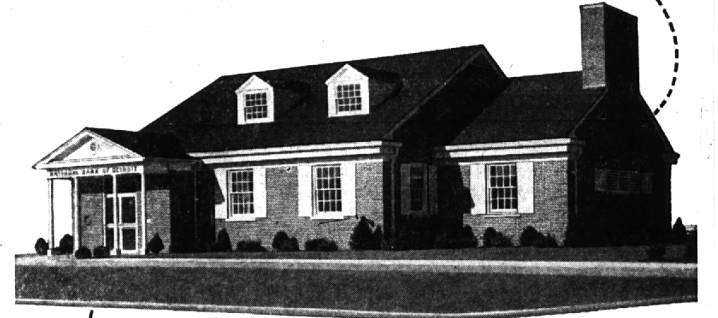
