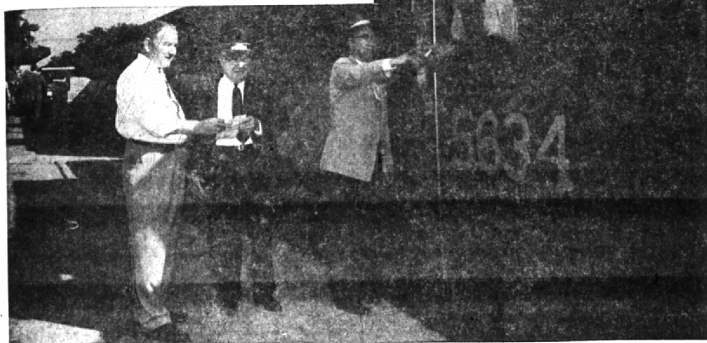

(Continued from Page 1, Sec. 1) mter knows, the huge parking lot added to the south of the station 10 years ago is filled to capacity nearly every day.

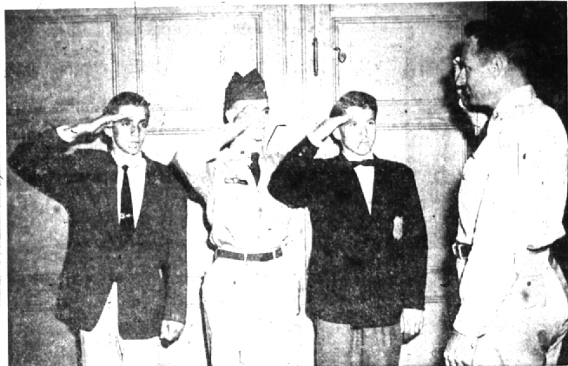
Birmingham Ticket Agent H. J. Wichman estimates that between 500 to 400 cars park at the station daily, with 500 to 600 commuters boarding the six trains each morning.

"Over three million commuters have been transported from this station since it opened," Wichman said.

FREIGHT HANDLED by the station is twenty times over the load of 25 years ago. There, Wichman said, 150 to 200 carloads of freight came into the local station every week. The annual total now reaches 4,000 carloads, he added.

"Dieselization," as Wichman puts it, is the current project of the railroad system, which means that within a few years commuters can expect to make their daily trip to the big city via Diesel trains.

"The entire Grand Trunk West-ern railroad system is about 90 per cent Dieselized right now," Wichman said, "and we hope to make it 100 per cent within the next five years or so."
