Michigan parks and recreation areas should set new attendance records this year, Brown predicted. In 1950, they entertained nearly 18 million visitors, while over 39,000 campers enjoyed the state-owned facilities.

As a public service, the booklet will be made available to all Birmingham-area motorists through the Auto Club office.
