A knowledge of the location of life insurance or disability insurance policies may be important to order to make immediate claims in case of a disabling accident.

I was introduced to the idea of establishing a small trust fund to provide for the care of my dependents. It seems there are living trusts and testamentary trusts and they're different and — but that's another story.

What I really found out was that unless I got my stuff arranged in a better way than I was going to cause someone a whole lot of trouble if I kicked off. So I called a friend of mine who knows about legal things and also sneaked in and took two extra vitamin pills.

Act 209, Public Acts of Michigan, 1955, as amended, provides as follows:

"The Inspectors of Election at any annual or special election shall not receive the vote of any person residing in a registration school district whose name is not registered as an elector in the city or township in which he resides."

THE LAST DAY on which persons may register with the appropriate city or township clerk in order to be eligible to vote at the Special Election to be held on September 10, 1956, is Friday, August 31, 1956. Persons registering after 5:00 o'clock p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on said Friday, August 31, 1956, will not be eligible to vote at said Special Election.

Under the provisions of Act 269, Public Acts of Michigan, 1955, as amended, registrations will not be taken by school officials, and only persons who have registered as general electors with the appropriate city or township clerk must ascertain the days and hours on which the clerk's office is open for registration.
