

Residents Fight Industrial Use Of Lincoln Lots

More than 100 residents of the Eton park area in Birmingham's southeast section tried for two hours Monday night to keep the city from selling two large lots for industrial purposes.

They succeeded—temporarily, at least.

Commissioners finally tabled the

two bids indefinitely until they see whether land use restrictions can be negotiated with the prospective owners.

Led by Sheffield Estates association president Robert Plawinski, 1742 Mansfield, and James Tamary, 1590 Cheltenham, the group pounded away at the city's intent to dispose of the property.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 496
City of Birmingham
AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCES

An Ordinance to amend Section 201 of Article 3 of Ordinance Number 221 of the City of Birmingham by the addition of a Section to be read as follows:

That Section 201 of Article 3 of Ordinance Number 221 be amended by the addition of a section to be known as Section 201.45, to read as follows:

SECTION 201.45. Property on the southeast corner of North Boulevard and Webster, described as: Lots 56, 57, and 58, Adams Park Subdivision shall be re-classified from its present classification of "public property" to "Business-B" classification.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication after the passage thereof.

This Ordinance made and passed by the Commission of the City of Birmingham this 6th day of August, A.D. 1956.
