The caseworker counsels the individual in the use of the services of this agency and other agencies in the community for help with such problems as securing and preparing for a vocation, obtaining employment and achieving a full personal life.

The organization's board members and designing committee, after an individual's abilities are discovered, takes work to the home-bound through the homework program.

The Junior League of Birmingham originally founded the organization but gave up the financial support two years, however, the local shop is still maintained by Junior League volunteers.
