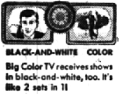

Troyton Manor extension group held its monthly meeting at the home of Mrs. Roger Cleary. Co-

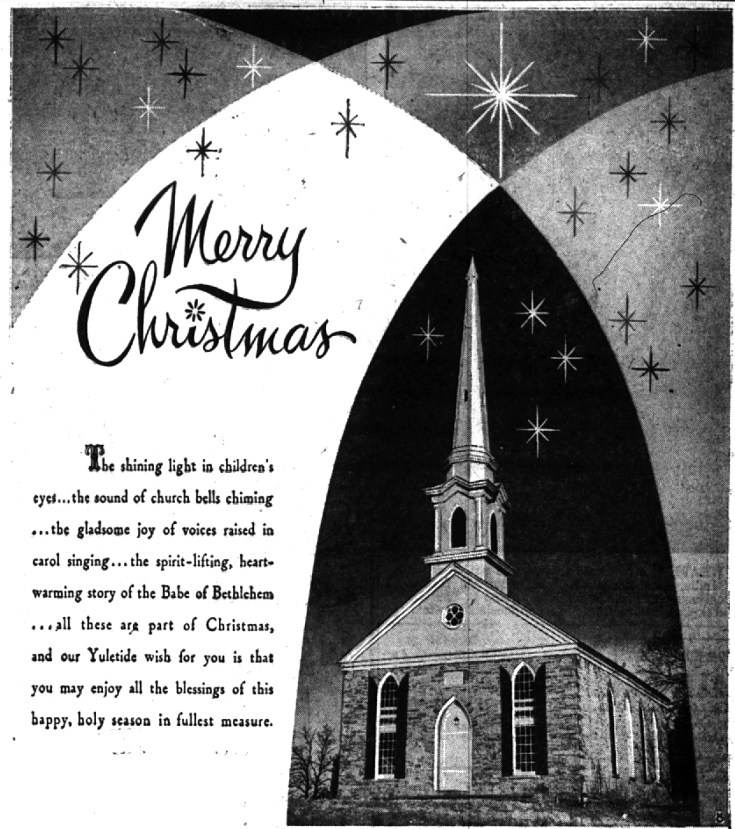
