E. S. Michelson, an experienced educator, will teach the Michigan State University course in principles of curriculum development during the winter term at Birmingham.

Interested area residents may enroll in the course by attending the first class session on Monday night, Jan. 7. The group will meet during the winter term on Monday nights from 7 to 10 at Birmingham high school.

Michelson, the instructor for this course, is assistant superintendent of the Livonia schools in charge of instruction, has served as principal at East Lansing and St. Clair, and as assistant superintendent of schools at Wyandotte. He is chairman of the Wayne county committee for gifted children.

THE COURSE will grant three term hours of graduate or undergraduate credit.

Michigan State is offering this course at Birmingham in response to numerous requests by area teachers and other interested adults.
