Hills Police Seek Clues to Cranbrook Statuary Vandalism

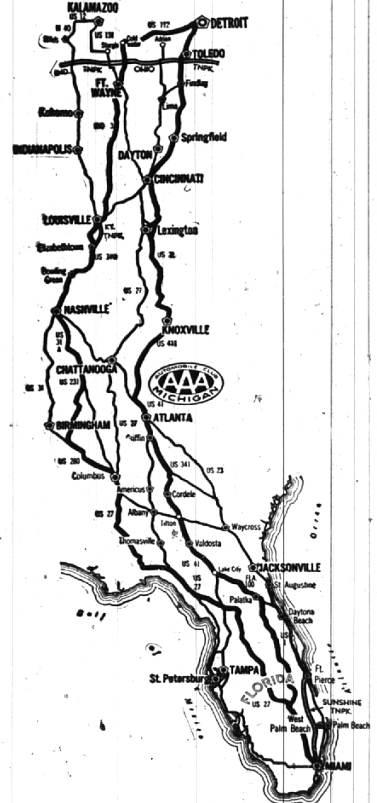
Bloomfield Hills police still are seeking clues to the identity of the vandals who shattered irreplaceable statuary at Cranbrook House on Nov. 27.

To Divide Property

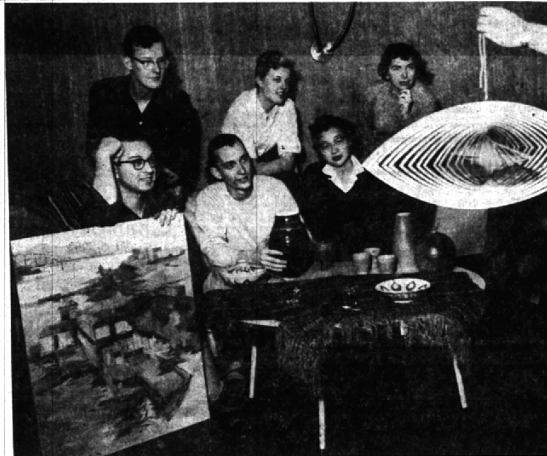

Would Place 3rd Child Guidance Clinic in SOC

Sixteen municipal and township governmental units and 17 school districts have been requested to furnish money to establish a branch child guidance clinic in southern Oakland county, according to Abraham Brickner, chairman of the SOC child guidance clinic steering committee.

Each school district has been asked to contribute four cents per \$1,000 of state equalized valuation and each community has been requested to give one-half cent per \$1,000 of state equalized values.

AMONG THOSE communities serviced by such a clinic would be Southfield and Troy.

BRICKNER indicated that interested citizens, service clubs and community groups are also being asked for financial assistance.
