You're glad that Christmas comes but once a year—when you start to pay the bills. In these days of easy credit—nothing down and a few pennies a week—many people have eyes bigger than their pocket books. Over-time pay and Christmas bonuses may be one shot deals too. It's so easy to say "charge it." The commercials on TV and radio and the "come on" ads in the paper tell you how easy it is to walk out with the goods but all these nice things have to be paid for.

Many of the big stores extend credit and sell merchandise on the installment plan to those able to make regular payments, but the small merchant in the neighborhood and the small town can't extend his resources very far. So, if those Christmas bills aren't paid promptly after the holidays, he may be forced to turn them over to someone for collection.

However, you purchase on a definite installment plan by signing a note or giving a chattel mortgage. The average open account becomes due in 30 days. After that the creditor may bring court action and collect costs and interest on top of the amount of the bill.

If he sues, the merchant can get a judgment in a matter of days and then proceed to garnish your wages—this can be embarrassing. Believe me, I don't want the sheriff calling shortly after Santa's visit. I'm going to watch my budget and pay my bills. How about you?
