Girard, Walls and Stanley Gilen, president of Forest Lake for the past year, were elected to the board of directors.

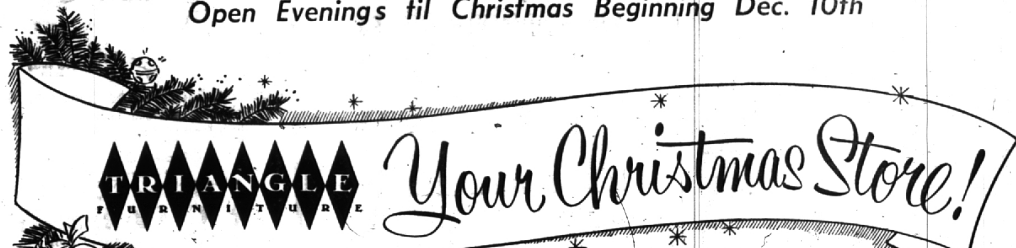
Moment Musicale Meets Tuesday
