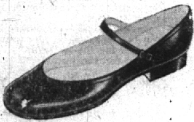

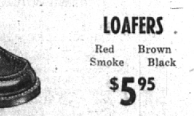

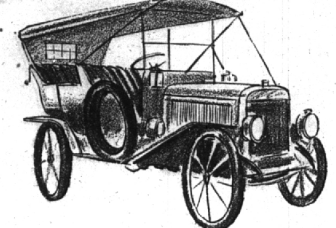
Mr. Ingraham is vice consul with the American Embassy in India and he and his family have been in India for the past year.
