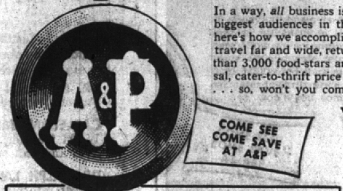
The string quartet participating include Axel Magnuson, William Hohmeyer and Saul Bernat, all of Birmingham.
