**Says the Barrister**

A "bailor" sounds like a man with a bucket in a leaky boat, and yet you may become one the next time you drive into a parking lot.

I keep learning how important contracts are in our daily lives. When we buy or sell something, or take a new job, most of us realize that we enter into a form of legal contract.

Some of our everyday activities we may not recognize as contracts, like leaving your hat in a restaurant checkroom.

SUCH ACTIONS often constitute a "bailment" contract, and you become the "bailor." The tall, trim blonde in the checkroom assumes a new name, too.

She—or her employer—becomes a "bailee," even though you prefer to call her "Blondie." If she should lose, or ruin, your hat, it would suddenly become important to you whether you have a "bailment" contract, or whether you yourself are responsible.

You've seen these signs in restaurants: "Not responsible for coats or hats, unless checked." Even without such a written warning, the proprietor is not liable.

IF YOU hang your hat on a public rack and it turns up missing, he is within his rights to say, "We're very sorry, but the rack is for your convenience only. You have to guard your own property; we have no responsibility."

But it's different when you use the checkroom, and pay for the service. You then have the legal definition of a "bailor" as where one person has lawfully acquired the possession of personal property of another and holds it under circumstances whereby he ought to keep it safely and restore it or
