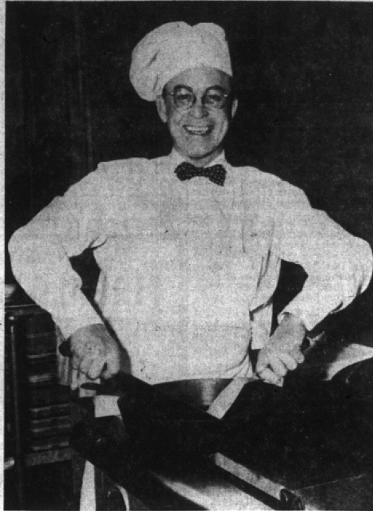

Punch a hole in the envelope and tie it to the end of the string.

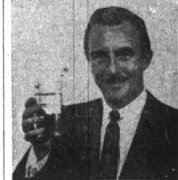

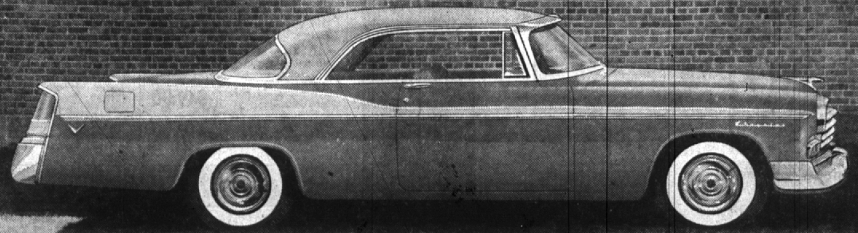
