



## Paintings from B'ham Exhibited in Kalamazoo

Paintings from a private Birmingham collection are part of a special exhibition at the Kalamazoo Art center this month.

(Mr. and Mrs. William J. Poplack, 511 Lake Park have lent some of the choicest works from their collection of American art for the exhibit, which opened Monday, Jan. 9, and will continue for a month.

Works by such great American artists as the 18th century James Peale, 19th century Winslow Homer and contemporaries, Charles Burchfield, Morris Graves, Ben Shahn, William Glackens and Charles Demuth are among those lent by the Poplacks. Ordinarily these paintings hang in their new home in Park Lake.

Also in the Kalamazoo exhibition are works by Michigan artists. Among them are Lisette Moser, Sarkis Sarkisian, Guy Palazola, Robert Culver, Wallace Mitchell, Harold Cohn, Ben Glicker, Hughie Lee-Smith and Constance Richardson from the collection of Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Fleischman of Detroit.

On Jan. 19, the Poplacks will accompany the Fleischmans to Kalamazoo for a reception. At that time, Mr. Fleischman will lecture on "Adventures in Collecting."

Another picture from the Poplack collection, "Moonflowers at Dusk" by Charles Burchfield, is in the Burchfield exhibition now on view at the Whitney Museum of American Art in New York. This collection is scheduled for a national tour later.
