5. The tubers are almost imperishable and can be used over and over again for more than 40 years. (This fact should be of very little interest of people

6. There are varieties that will be at home in the garden, in the house, hanging up or on your blouse, etc. They can be planted in the garden or carried the year around in pots. They start a little easier indoors in flats or saucers.

7. Plant outdoors about 7 to 10 days earlier than tomato planting time. If started indoors they can be planted outdoors after all danger of frost is past . . . or at the time you set out tomato plants.

8. To make it easier we have discovered that you can obtain tubers at a small shop on Brownell Street.

Gloxinia—dulture similar to Begonias. Succession of blooms can be had by planting tubers at two-week intervals.

Lily-of-the-Valley—A Spring flower of exquisite form and unutterably exquisite fragrance. Will bloom indoors in about 3 weeks.

Amarylis—Imagine having glossy strap-like leaves with two to four large lily-like flowers appearing in an umbel at the tip of a hollow scape. All this can happen in the house, garden, green house, sun porch or window garden! Imagine!!
