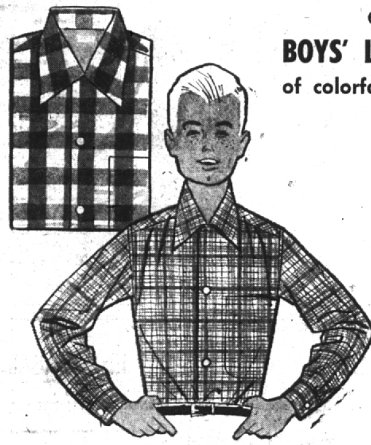
Student Elected
