August Mackelberghe, noted Belgian-American concert organist and composer, will present his annual evening recital at the Detroit Institute of Arts Tuesday, Feb. 14. Included in the program will be a group of the artist's own compositions, as well as works by Bach, Dufay, Franck, Liszt and Van Den Kerkhof.

Mackelberghe, who is organist and music director of St. John's Episcopal church, Detroit, will be performing on the municipally-owned Casavant in the Art Institute. This fall he tape-recorded two concerts on the organ at St. John's for broadcast over the Belgian National radio, which were most enthusiastically received.


### Dinner Honors Board Member


