## Kitendaugh-Otis Rites Performed In East Tuesday

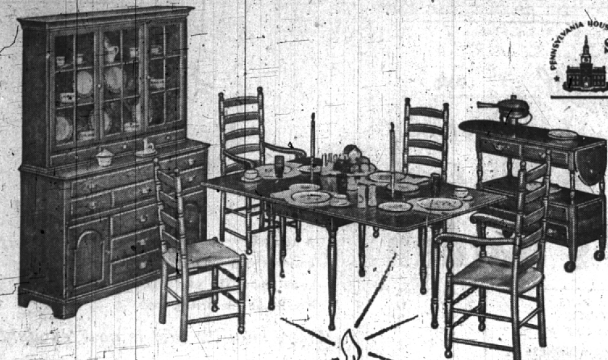
