**Motorists Should
Be On the Alert—
Police Are!**

"All police officers will be on the alert for motorists committing the violations which cause most of Birmingham's accidents," says Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley.

Alertness, he continues, should also be exercised by drivers. Otherwise, following too closely and violating the right of way may cause them to add another to the total of 185 accidents caused by these two violations this year.

"Following too closely" results from driving too fast for conditions or inattention on the part of the driver. "Right of way" violations are the result of running a red or amber signal and such improper actions as failing to make a complete stop at a stop sign.

"The accident record for the first six months of 1956 is worse than the '55 toll in almost every phase of the accident picture," Moxley said. Total accidents reached 331, with 263 at this time last year.
