Southfield, Park Pavings Are OK'd
 Two paving special assessment rolls have been confirmed by Birmingham city commissioners. One is for widening of Southfield to 33 feet from 14 Mile to Lincoln. The county has agreed to pay half the estimated \$35,400 cost.
 If the city can find a contractor, it will be widened this year, said City Manager D. C. Egbert.
 The other project was paving of Park, from Oakland north to Euclid. This estimated \$11,500 job will be paid 85 per cent by private property owners. This work cannot be done this year, said Egbert.


One Resignation Gets Resistance
