B'ham Junior Achievers Have Record-Breaking Year

A record-breaking year in sales, profits and dividends was chalked up by the eight Birmingham junior achievement companies in their operations which ended in mid-May.

Wallace L. Fleming, executive director of junior achievement of southeastern Michigan, announced that local teen-agers grossed \$2,616 in the "Learn by Doing" operation their own miniature business corporations from October, 1955 through last month.

Other statistics on Birmingham's teenage businessmen and women are:

NET PROFITS totaling \$518; average dividends to the hundreds of investors who purchased stock in the firms (at 50 cents a share) of 10 per cent; total "income tax" paid by the Birmingham JA firms, \$55. The tax money goes to the Achiever's Association which carries on social activities for all JA members and provides travel awards for delegates to JA conferences.

Fleming singled out the Gadgeco Co., sponsored by Vickers, Inc., as Birmingham's outstanding JA firm. The company, headed by president Dick Spicer, 19, of 2050 Wilshire, Berkeley, grossed more than \$800 on sale of its novel aluminum gold score card holder. It also won first place in local JA Industry Awards for the best aluminum manufacturing concern in this JA area.


EACH JA FIRM requires sponsorship by a concern which will provide a team of three executives to counsel the boys and girls in problems of management, production and sales.

The volunteer advisors are oriented in the JA program during the summer months. From October through May they spend one afternoon or evening a week for two hours working with the achievers in their JA firm.
