

# Candidates Make Plans To Attend LWV Rally

Floats are well on their way to completion, old cars are being reved up, bands and choruses are practicing, and the candidates and new voters are alerted to be on hand for the torchlight parade which starts at Chester and Martin next Thursday night at 7:30 p.m.

The Birmingham League of Women Voters are sponsoring the parade and the candidates' rally and new voter birthday party which will follow it.

Among the candidates who will be these are, for governor: Donald S. Leonard (R), and invitations (D), Hazel Park; Paul Sutton (D), have been received by Albert E. Royal Oak; George N. Higgins (R),

**THE OUTDOOR** candidates' rally will be opened by Mrs. John Ramsey, president of the Birmingham League of Women Voters, and Mayor James Allen, who will welcome all those attending. Mistress Blunt, will introduce the national and state candidates as well as the non-partisan candidates for probate judge.

Republican and Democratic county chairmen, Chad Ritchie and Carlos Richardson, will flip a coin to decide which will introduce his Oakland county candidates first.

During the rally popcorn and soft drinks will be sold by the Birmingham high school Varsity club members, under the direction of Kermit Ambrose. In case of rain, the candidates' rally will be held in the Baldwin school gymnasium at the corner of W. Maple and Chester at 8:30 p.m.

**IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING** the rally, all new voters will adjourn to the parlor of St. James church for the new voter birthday party.
