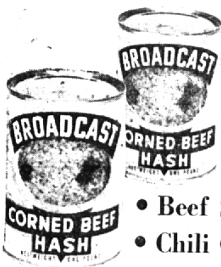

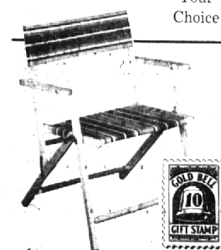

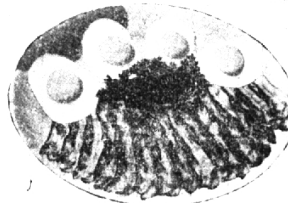
Peas in Pods
