Bloomfield Township is largely composed of high type residential areas which are closely restricted. It includes some of the most exclusive and wealthy residential sections in the State. The Township has no direct debt. It elvies no general taxes, as state-shared taxes are sufficient to cover operating costs.

Water System No. I largely comprises the area extending from the westerly limits of Birmingham, to Lahser Road, and from Fourteen Mile Road to Quarton Road, except portions of the Distyte located immediately north of Fourteen Mile Road and at the corner of Lahser Road and Quarton Road.

These bonds, in the opinion of Codnsel, will not be a general obligation of the Township, but will be payable solely from the net revenues of Water System No. 1, including all improvements, enlargements, and extensions thereof. A first lien has been created on the net revenues for the payment of these bonds and any additional bonds of equal standing.
