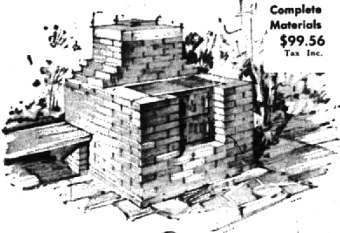

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that any person who is not already registered upon the registration books of said township may register on or before July 9th, 1956, from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M., Eastern Standard Time and on any day previous thereto, except Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays from 9:00 o'clock to 5:00 o'clock P.M. The Township Office will be open each Monday on or before July 9, 1956, from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Citizens of the United States, 21 years old, who have resided in the State of Michigan six months and in the Township of Bloomfield thirty days prior to August 7, 1956, are eligible to register.

Those persons who have already registered under the permanent registration system and have voted within the last four years do not have to re-register.
