The following evening, about 70 young people gathered for the party at the Basfords.

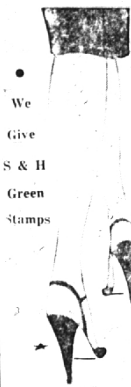
### Posts in New Home

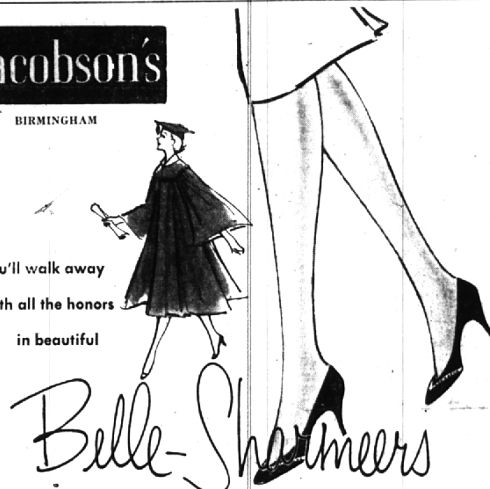
