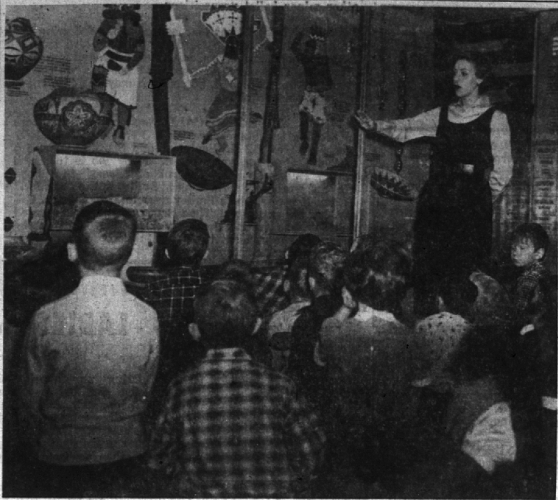


**B-25 Boy Scouts Meet Tonight At Court of Honor**

**School Board Sets 2 Dinner Meetings**

Dinner meetings have been set by the Birmingham school board for next Monday night with the Birmingham PTA and Tuesday evening with the administrative council. Administrative council, made up of school principals and assistant school superintendents, will present the board with information on outdoor education. At the Monday night meeting with the PTA at Birmingham high school, a film, "School boards in action," will be shown. The board then will answer questions on school board operation and functions.

OTHER board action at Tuesday night's meeting included purchase of classroom furniture for Derby junior high and application for special state subsidy for the Derby classroom furniture which includes 1005 study top desks, 29 teacher desks, 46 teachers chairs and 8 conference desks, will be purchased from the McFadden Co. for \$20,262 with delivery set for prior to the school's opening in Sept., 1956.

The school district will receive up to \$25 for each student completing the course in driver education.
