Primary Disability Benefits—Covered Member
Section 22. Upon his retirement on account of disability, as provided in section 20 hereof, a covered member shall receive a primary disability retirement allowance computed according to section 16 (a), (b), (c) and (e) hereof...

Primary Disability Benefits—Non Covered Member
Section 23. Upon his retirement on account of disability, as provided in section 20 hereof, a non-covered member shall receive a primary disability retirement allowance computed according to section 16 (a), (b), (c) and (e) hereof...

Additional Duty Disability Benefit
Section 24. If the Board finds (1) that a retiree is in receipt of a primary disability retirement allowance...

Re-examination of Disability Status
Section 25. (a) At least once each year during the first five years following the retirement of a member with a disability retirement allowance...

Duty Death Benefits
Section 26. In the event (1) a member dies as the result of a personal injury or disease arising out of and in the course of his employment with the City...

Refund of Accumulated Contributions
Section 27. (a) Should any member cease to be an officer or employee of the City and not be receiving a pension payable from funds provided by the City...

Section 28. (a) The annuity savings fund is hereby created. It shall be the fund in which shall be accumulated at regular intervals, the contributions of each member...

Section 29. (a) The retirement reserve fund is hereby created. It shall be the fund from which shall be paid all annuities and pensions payable as provided in this chapter...

Section 30. The pension reserve fund is hereby created. It shall be the fund in which shall be accumulated reserves for the payment of the annuities and pensions provided by the City...

(2) To borrow on the general credit of the fund or to pledge or mortgage the said fund or any part thereof, at such time and in such manner, either at public or private sale and upon such terms as in its absolute and uncontrolled discretion the said Board may deem expedient...

(3) To exercise any option or privilege to convert bonds, notes, stocks or other securities belonging to such funds into other bonds, notes, stocks or other securities...

(4) To unite with other owners of property or securities similar to any plan for the consolidation or merger, dissolution or liquidation, foreclosure, sale or lease...

(5) To enforce, abandon, adjust, arbitrate, compromise, sue on or defend, and otherwise deal with and settle claims in favor of or against the City...
