"Miss Michigan of 1956," assisted by Russell Swainey, 805 Redding, Birmingham, Michigan Vice general chairman, commended officials for their enthusiastic cooperation on the exchange and urged that the paired towns start immediately to co-ordinate plans for the day's program.
Usually, the cities and villages go all out to welcome the visiting mayor and his party by entertaining the group with tours, parades, banquets, and other civic festivities.

THE EXCHANGE is planned for a Monday, the day most cities hold their council meetings and the visiting officials usually conduct business. O'Keefe pointed out the event was originally designed to help Michigan communities to become better acquainted with one another.
"Since the first exchange in 1954," he said, the program has generated a considerable enthusiasm among municipal leaders. Last year 366 mayors and village presidents exchanged, with many endorsing the program as "a most constructive" one, he said.
Pairings are strictly by chance in the drawing, with no regard to size of equal size or close geographic locations. The results have produced some unusual combinations with metropolitan areas exchanging with villages, and with towns in the Upper Peninsula swapping with southern Michigan cities.
