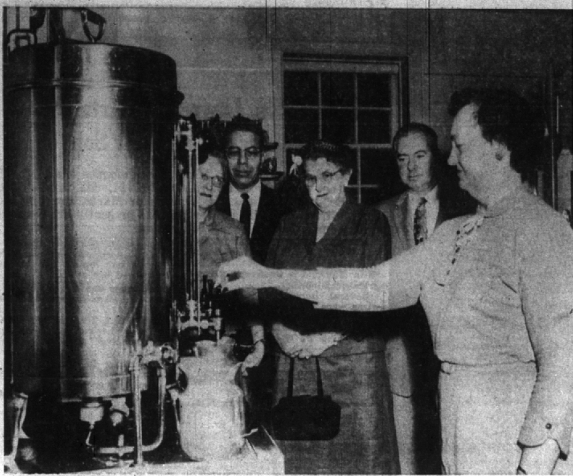

Mix Up Clay For Kids' Indoor Play

Indoor play for the pre-school child can become a problem when old man weather persists in having winter. How do you keep them busy while you carry on your household duties?
 One solution to this problem is given by Grace Harrison of the child development staff at Michigan State University. She suggests you make a batch of dough for your child.
 The dough is easily made by mixing together two cups of flour and one cup of salt; then add one-third cup water or enough to get a consistency similar to bread dough. The addition of the large amount of salt gives the dough a spongy consistency and delays spoilage.
 YOUR CHILD will enjoy adding the color to the dough, or even making the dough if he is old enough. The color can be either vegetable dye, tempera or powder paint.
 This dough is similar to clay except it is cleaner and also more pliable. This makes it easier for the very small child to mold. The two-year old youngster will roll it or just pinch it, but the older boy or girl will mold it into shapes.
 When the child has finished his object, leave it in the air to dry or bake it in a moderate oven for half an hour, suggests the child-growth specialist. She points out that although this object will not last very long, there is a great deal gained by the child in completing the process.
