Builders' Idea Home A "Housewife's Dream"

Ideas aimed at making the homemaker's lot an easier one are included in the hundreds of new designs and furnishing wringles built in the 1956 Builders Show Idea Home, located on West 12 Mile road between Southfield and Evergreen.

The designer, George B. Zonar, Cranbrook Academy architectural graduate student, the supervising architect, Palmquist & Wright, the interior decorator, Mrs. Bette Wilson of the J. L. Hudson Co. worked very closely in an effort to make the Idea Home a true housewife's dream, according to Mrs. Kay Prost, manager of the Builders Home Show.

THE DESIGN group also sought the services of Dr. Frances G. Sanderson, chairman of the home economics department of Wayne University, and a national authority in the field of work-saving kitchen design, particularly for heart patients.

Basic elements in the floor plan and plot layout contribute greatly to ease of maintenance and saving of steps, Mrs. Prost notes.

EXTENSIVE use of the floors and sound-conditioning ceiling tile also contribute to ease of maintenance. Connected to the heating and air-conditioning system is a Precipitron electronic air filter which, by removing airborne dust, cuts down necessary cleaning.

Homemakers who want to study the work-saving features of the Idea Home would do well to visit it on a weekday, Mrs. Prost said, when a more leisurely tour is possible. The Idea Home is open from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m. daily and from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

The home, sponsored by the Builders Association of Metropolitan Detroit, will be awarded at the Builders Home Show, April 7-15 at the State Fairgrounds.
