

Mt. Clemens Tops Maple Reserves

A tight zone defense and a late scoring rally by Mt. Clemens cost Birmingham reserve cagers a 61-48 defeat there Friday night.

Neither team could find the range in the first half, but Dave Richie's six points and Chuck Gibson's rebounding were the main factors in the Maple 17-13 lead at halftime.

AFTER intermission the game switched from a defensive contest to the battle of offenses.

Bather Jim Mastens went on a nine point scoring spree in the third quarter to aid Mt. Clemens in losing Birmingham 20-30 when the stanza ended.

Early in the last period the Bathers jumped to a four point lead, but with a little over three minutes showing on the clock Gibson converted a rebound into two points for the Maples and a 42-42 deadlock.

MT. CLEMENS used skillful offensive movements to score nine points in the time that remained. Ritchie hit 21 points to lead all scorers. The only other Maple player to tally double figures was Gibson with 11. Mastens hit 17 and Howard Sharber 13 for the winners.
